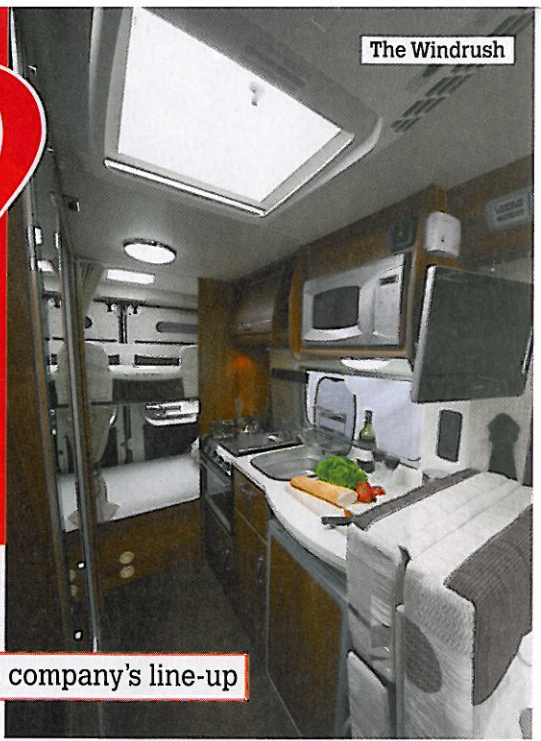

Auto-Sleepers Bunks and beautiful exteriors join this Cotswold company's line-up

When you think about Auto-Sleepers you generally imagine a traditional British 'van. However, all that has changed with the introduction of the 2012 models – with a motorhome aimed at families and stunning new exteriors for Peugeot coachbuilds.

It isn't so unusual that a British manufacturer has introduced a motorhome for families, but it is rare that this comes in the form of a high top. The Windrush is based on the LWB Peugeot Boxer and offers four berths and four belted travel seats.

Other features include a sliding sink in the washroom, three-burner hob and oven, extractor fan, reversing camera, awning, removable carpets, an external barbecue point and a fitted gas tank.

And then there's the new look for the Peugeot coachbuilds. A sleek low profile adorns the new models, with an opening skylight over the cab. Matching black panels and graphics make this a great looking 'van.

The use of aluminium side skirts, sturdier aluminium bed boxes (with gas struts) and the new exterior shape has created a lighter 'van offering new customers around 50kg of extra payload on the Broadway. The Broadway also comes with a more powerful heater, a door with integrated bin, LED marker lights, extra sockets and more storage in the washroom.

The Nuevo has also benefited from similar improvements.
